## Registration Time!

\* Students MUST turn in their registration forms to the guidance department before spring break. Students cannot meet with the guidance counselors and complete the registration process UNTIL their parents have signed and turned in their forms.

\* There are going to be five dual enrollment courses that will be offered for juniors and seniors next year. In order to take a dual enrollment class, you must have an ACT composite score of 19. There is a mandatory parent meeting on April 3, at 6:00 P. M. for those students interested in taking a dual enrollment class.

Currently, the Hope Scholarship pays for one dual enrollment class (valued at \$300) per semester.
